Meeting OSHA Injury & Illness Prevention Requirements

Is Your Program Up to Par?

OSHA standards are rules that describe the methods that employers must use to protect their employees from hazards. There are OSHA standards for Construction work, Agriculture, Maritime operations, and General Industry, which are the standards that apply to most worksites. These standards limit the amount of hazardous chemicals workers can be exposed to, require the use of certain safe practices and equipment, and require employers to monitor hazards and keep records of workplace injuries and illnesses.

Section 5(a)(1) of the OSH Act, often referred to as the General Duty Clause, requires employers to "furnish to each of his employees employment and a place of employment which are free from recognized hazards that are causing or are likely to cause death or serious physical harm to its employees". Section 5(a)(2) requires employers to "comply with occupational safety and

health standards promulgated under this Act".

In January 2011, new requirements took effect by way of **AB 2774**. This workshop will consist of some theory but mostly practical ways to determine if your current IIPP is in compliance with **AB 2774**. A sample/model IIPP that will meet these new regulations will be available for those requesting same. At the completion of this workshop, all participants will have a good understanding of **AB 2774** and as it relates to current IIPP regulations and further will learn:

What **AB 2774** is and what it really means for employers and how this could change the way you do business; why your IIPP and safety training documentation becomes even more important with **AB 2774**; what are the latest developments with **AB 2774** and what have we learned since its passage; and what to do when faced with a serious violation - what's the best way to respond to the 1BY Form.
