Meeting OSHA Injury & Illness Prevention Requirements

Is Your Program Up to Par?

OSHA standards are rules that describe the methods that employers must use to protect their employees from hazards. There are OSHA standards for Construction work, Agriculture, Maritime operations, and General Industry, which are the standards that apply to most worksites. These standards limit the amount of hazardous chemicals workers can be exposed to, require the use of certain safe practices and equipment, and require employers to monitor hazards and keep records of workplace injuries and illnesses.

In January 2011, new requirements took effect by way of **Assembly Bill 2774**. Join us on June 26 for an in-depth presentation to learn more about how California employers can be better prepared and protect themselves. It starts with having a compliant and effective **Injury & Illness Prevention Program** (IIPP). **Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations** (CCR), requires every California employer to have an effective

IIPP in writing, which must be in accordance with Section 3203 of the General Industry Safety Orders (www.dir.ca.gov/Title8/3203.html). We will discuss in detail the elements of an IIPP and how to devise a strategic plan focused on reducing hazards and complying with Cal/OSHA and AB 2774.

A sample/model IIPP that will meet these new regulations will be available for those requesting same. At the completion of this workshop, all participants will have a good understanding of **AB 2774** and as it relates to current IIPP regulations.
